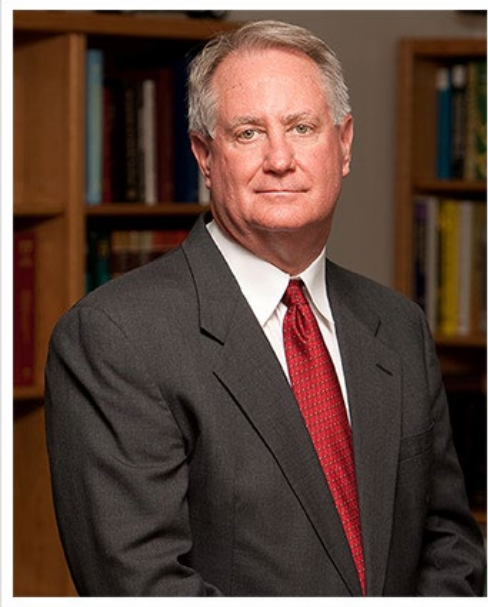


FIRE AND ARSON EXPERT QUALIFICATION
